Approval Process

- Teacher fills out grant form
- Submit and approval from principal
- Submit to superintendent for approval –
 - ✓ Moves to grant committee upon superintendent approval
 - ✓ Grant committee reviews submissions
 - Grant committee may ask for additional information
 - Grant approved or passed on
 - Teacher moves forward with grant execution
 - NCPE will generate payment to teacher for expenses
 - NCPE will present grant at board meeting
 - NCPE will generate marketing and communication
 - NCPE will perform due diligence on grant execution
